### **Electrical Apprenticeship Program**

Application for the 2024–2025 School Year

The HCECA Electrical Apprenticeship Program is a four-year electrical apprenticeship program approved and certified by the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Council, Registry #919 and the United States Department of Labor. This program is a combination of on-the-job training and classroom instruction. Upon successful completion of the program, students are awarded a Journeyperson Certificate from the Maryland Department of Labor. They are then eligible for an examination waiver and may apply for their Electrical Journeyperson license with the State of Maryland.

Classes will begin in September 2024 and run through April 2025 at Edgewood Hall on the campus of Harford Community College, 401 Thomas Run Road, Bel Air, Maryland.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

#### Applicant must:

- Be at least 18 years old (work permit required if under 18).
- Have a high school diploma or GED.
- Have reliable transportation to school and to work.
- Successfully complete a math comprehension assessment.
- Have a valid email address and are able to access online curriculum with device other than cell phone.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

#### **1.** Apply

Applications are accepted throughout the entire year. The application deadline for the upcoming 2024-25 school year is May 31, 2024.

#### 2. Assessment

All applicants will be required to take a basic math comprehension assessment. You will receive a letter via email and U.S. mail with instructions on scheduling this assessment, between January and May of 2024.

#### **3.** Interview

After assessment scores have been evaluated, an interview will be scheduled. Please arrange to obtain high school diploma/transcript or GED scores for your scheduled interview (except for those graduating from high school in 2024 – you may provide a copy of your diploma once received). Acceptances will be determined by July 31.

#### **EMPLOYMENT**

You are <u>required</u> to find employment in the electrical trade with an HCECA member contractor during your apprenticeship. All employers must be a member of the Harford County Electrical Contractors Association. If not a member, employers can join at a minimal cost of \$100/year. (*Most union contractors cannot join our association due to the collective bargaining agreement they have signed with their local chapter.*)

Apprentices are required to complete 8,000 hours of on-the-job training (this is a full-time, 40-hour a week job) and 576 hours of related classroom instruction over 4 years. Employment referrals are available upon request.

#### **CLASSROOM TRAINING**

- 2 evenings per week from 6:15 9:00 PM for a total of 144 hours per year
- Classes are held in Edgewood Hall on the campus of Harford Community College, 401 Thomas Run Road, Bel Air, Maryland.
- Apprentices must maintain a minimum GPA of 70% to advance in the program.

#### **TUITION**

Full tuition payment is due by August 22, 2024. Some employers offer financial assistance so be sure to inquire with your place of employment.
